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A B S T R A C T

A total of 100-day-old straight run broiler chicks were used in this farm practice.

Strict hygiene and sanitation was observed and good supply of water and feeds was provided.

Birds were fed with broiler starter mash in the first six weeks and then fed with broiler finisher mash in the last two weeks. Birds were fed ad libitum. The total feed consumption was 199 kilogram with an average of 2.03 kilograms per bird.

With the good management applied the Student Outreach Agent (SOA) and the cooperator were able to produce birds with an average liveweight of 1.7 kilogram and which are needed at ₱12.00 per kilogram.

A net labor return of ₱3.56 per bird was met or as a whole a net labor return of ₱349.75 per 100 birds.

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
