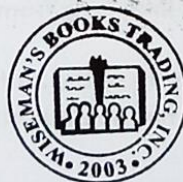

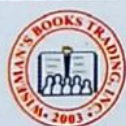
## Mary Jane Anannayo-Sanao, Ph.D.
