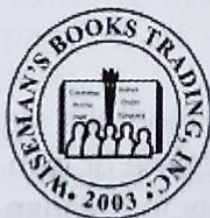

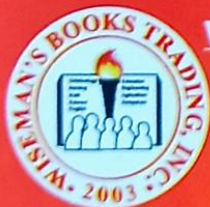
With this advocacy, we are looking forward for the internationalization of our profession that maybe comparable to international standards.
