ABSTRACT

NUESTRO, RODEL ROMANES, "Masagana Feeds, Incorporated: A Case Study." Bachelor of Science in AgriBusiness, Don Severino Agricultural College, April 1992. Adviser: Ms. Lina C. Abogadie.

A three-month field practice was conducted at Masagana Feeds, Incorporated in Bocaue, Bulacan from November 6, 1991 to February 6, 1992 to gain knowledge, skills and tools in agribusiness management to real life situation and experiences; to study the management of Masagana Feeds, Incorporated; to identify the problems of the firm and to propose probable solution to such problems.

During the conduct of the field study, the student was exposed to the different activities of feeds production management. Production, marketing and management aspects of the firm were assessed.

Problems identified include the decrease in sales, the organizational set-up, internal problems, staffing process and the leniency of the lending policy of the company.

The company's organizational structure must revealed what really exist to prevent conflict in authority. It must also set-up a clear policy regarding the hiring of people and must maintain a moderate lending policy.

INTRODUCTION

Feedmilling is one of the most important agri-based industries in our country. Swine, poultry and other livestock production are vitally linked to it.
