ABSTRACT

The farm practice, "Production and Cultural Management of Corn" was conducted in Barrio Kaytambog Indang, Cavite from June 1937 to February 1988. This aimed to encourage the farmer to use the modern techniques in the production of corn and give the right method of producing good yield of corn.

A 2,500 square meters of land was used in this project. The land was plowed two times and immediately harrowed. Planting of corn was done October 31, 1987 with an spacing of 50 by 60 centimeters using three seeds of corn in a furrow.

Urea fertilizer (46-0-0) was applied at exactly 28 days after planting at the rate of 50 kilograms (200 kilograms per hectare).

Harvesting was done on February 7, 1988. A total of 120 kilograms of corn was obtained from the project. This was sold at \$76.00 per kilo. The gross income was \$7720.00 and upon deducting the total expenses of \$7553.00, a net income of \$7167.00 was realized.

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
