ABSTRACT

A four- month field study was conducted to enable the trainee to apply her knowledge learned from the classroom to actual business operations and to describe the operations of the firm in terms of production of the firms products which involve the production process of diaper and tissue paper, marketing of the said products through distribution channels from manufacturer to end user and organization and management which explains the SCA Hygiene Products ownership and business composition, in addition, the study aimed to identify problems by the firms and discuss the activities performed in the firm during the conduct of the field study.

INTRODUCTION

Paper derived its name from the word "papyrus", a reed plant that used to grow in the Nile Valley. It is made of cellulose fibers formed into sheet on a screen from water suspension. A paper is produced by chopping fibrous materials such as rags, straw, bark, wood and others, which are then sun dried. The basic raw material in paper making is cellulose which occur in the form of fiber in a wide variety of plants. Example of paper products are base paper, bond paper, coated paper, construction paper, cotton fiber, cover paper, tissue paper and others (Imphang,1990).

Tissue paper, a general term indicating a class of paper of characteristic gauzy texture, in some cases fairly transparent. It includes sanitary tissue, wrapping tissue, waxing tissue stock, twisting tissue stock, fruit and vegetable wrapping tissue stock, pattern tissue stock, sales book tissue stock, and crepe wadding.
