#### ABSTRACT

A three-month field study was conducted at Ink for Less at 2303A, 23<sup>rd</sup> Floor, West Tower, Philippine Stock Exchange, Exchange Road, Ortigas Center, Pasig City. #### INTRODUCTION

An ink is a liquid containing various pigments and dyes used for coloring a surface to produce an image, text, or design. Ink is used for drawing or writing with a pen, brush or quill. Thicker inks, in paste form, are used extensively in letterpress and lithographic printing. Ink is composed of surfactant, particulate matter, fluoresces, and other materials. The components of inks serve many purposes: the ink's carrier, colorants, and other additives are used to control flow and thickness of the ink and its appearance (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Ink).

Customarily, customers are encouraged to use the ink cartridge produced by the same manufacturer of their printers. Contrary to this norm, cartridge units may just be refilled so that they can lower ink costs and prolong cartridge performance.

Having the ink units recycled is simple and easy. What the user does is take his empty cartridge at a refilling station, where it will be thoroughly cleaned, professionally
