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ABSTRACT

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The study was conducted to determine the Problems Encountered in Teaching of Secondary Physical Education Teachers of Selected Public Schools in Dasmariñas City Cavite specifically the study aimed to: 1. determine the demographic characteristics of the Secondary Physical education teachers of selected Public Schools in Dasmariñas City Cavite such as age, sex, highest educational attainment and field of specialization 2. determine problems Encountered in Teaching of Secondary Physical Education Teachers of Selected Public Schools in Dasmariñas City Cavite 3. to know if there any significant relationship on the Problems Encountered in Teaching Physical Education of Secondary Physical Education Teachers of Selected Public Schools in Dasmariñas Cavite and their Demographic characteristics.

The participants were 147 secondary physical education teachers of Selected Public Schools namely Dasmariñas Integrated High School, Dasmariñas North National High School, Langkaan II National High School, New Era National High School, Dasmariñas East National High School, Paliparan National High School, Congressional Integrated National High School, Francisco E. Barzaga National High School, Salawag National High School, Pag-Asa National High School, Dasmariñas West National High School and Paliparan II Integrated High School. Descriptive total enumeration was used in determining the participants in the study and SRS or simple random sampling in selecting the participating schools.

Survey questionnaire made the researchers was used in the collection of the data; data were analyzed using Frequency and Percentage, Weighted mean and Chi- Square Test of Association. The results showed that age, sex, highest educational attainment and specialization have significant relationship with their perception of facilities as a common problems encountered in teaching physical education.

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INTRODUCTION

Philippines is one the most problematic countries when it comes to educational system in the world. The country has different problems in its school systems yet neglected and still not giving full attention to. This issue could have a big effect not just on the students but to teachers and school itself.
