ABSTRACT

GIDA, LOVELY B. An Evaluation on the Livelihood Program of Municipal Social Welfare Development Office (MSWDO) Tanza, Cavite. Undergraduate Thesis, Bachelor of Science in Social Work. Cavite State University, Indang Cavite. May 2017. Adviser: Ms. Emma Perey

This research was conducted to determine and evaluate the perceived effectiveness and impact of the livelihood programs of Municipal Social Welfare Development Office (MSWDO) Tanza, Cavite that brought the beneficiaries a development in socio-economic status and as well being, and also determined the problem encountered by the beneficiaries regarding the livelihood program. These were being gathered through purposive or criterion sampling method to answer the researcher's self-made questionnaire that acquired both qualitative and quantitative information. Descriptive evaluation was employed to strive for clarification of description to explain and interpret the responses from beneficiaries.

A total of 50 beneficiaries who were at least 25 years old and above were the participants of the study. The time allotted for data gathering, interpreting and accomplishing the manuscript was from January to May 2017

The MSWDO has some partners on the implementation of livelihood program like Department of Agriculture (DA) and Department of Trade and Industry (DTI). Out of eight livelihood that being listed to the questionnaire, there was only two programs that were allowed to be evaluated, and these were Nagkakaisang Mamamayan ng Tanza (NagMaTa):Bigasang Bayan and Dishwashing liquid making.

INTRODUCTION

Poverty initially appears so complex that its solution seems tantamount to resolving the entire development issue itself. It may, therefore, be validly asked whether poverty is not really beyond the capacity of any single administration to address, and whether its relief is a futile agendum (Emmanuel de Dios and associates, 1993). To reduce poverty, the social workers' role is to seek for help and to mobilize resources for the implementation of Livelihood Programs.

Tanza is a municipality in the province of Cavite, Philippines. Politically subdivided into 41 barangays with the land area of 78.24 square kilometres which has a total of 226,188 population. The ninth most populous municipality and 16th largest Municipal Revenue Earner based on 2014 Bureau of Local Government Financial Report. The Department of Social Welfare Office – Tanza, Cavite is headed by Betty Perlada-Real, RSW. According to Ms. Carolyn B. Perez, Social Welfare Officer III, some of
