#### **ABSTRACT**

The study was a Comparative Analysis of the films *Filipinas* and *Tanging Yaman* on the Image Portrayal of Mother. The study was conducted at Cavite State University from November 2004 to February 2005. It was conducted to analyze and compare the films *Filipinas* and *Tanging Yaman* and to determine the images of mother portrayed in the films. Specifically, it aimed to present the summary/ synopsis of the two films, characterize the similarities and differences of the films *Filipinas* and *Tanging Yaman* in terms of its theme and identify the images of a mother portrayed in the said films based on its scenes.
