ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was to present an overview of the research on "Impact of Sustainable Livelihood Program (SLP) to the beneficiaries in Dasmariñas City and Trece Martires City, Cavite. It aimed to determine the demographic profile of the beneficiaries in terms of age, sex, educational attainment, occupation and monthly income, determine the impacts of SLP to the beneficiaries, identify the problems encountered by the SLP to the beneficiaries, and cite the possible suggestions from the participants

The research was supported by a quantitative approach specifically descriptive method, also known as the survey or normative approach to assess the impact of Sustainable Livelihood Program of the beneficiaries in the city of Dasmarinas and Trece Martires in the province of Cavite.
