ABSTRACT

The study was conducted at JR&R Distributors, Inc. Cavite in Pasong Kawayan I Gen. Trias, Cavite from January 9 to March 10 2017. The study aimed to analyze the current warehouse management of the company. Specifically this study aimed to describe the profile and operation of the company; describe the warehouse management practices of the company, identify the current inventory management practices of the company, analyze the warehouse & inventory management practices using SWOT analysis, and identify the problems encountered to recommend possible solutions to the problems identified.

The data were gathered from the records of the firm, including personal interviews, and observations of the researcher in his three-month stay in the company.

Descriptive method was used in analyzing the information gathered to describe the warehouse management system and inventory management practices with the aid of a process flow chart, which starts from the receiving process and ends with the dispatching process of the products, and an analysis of the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats of the existing inventory control system.
